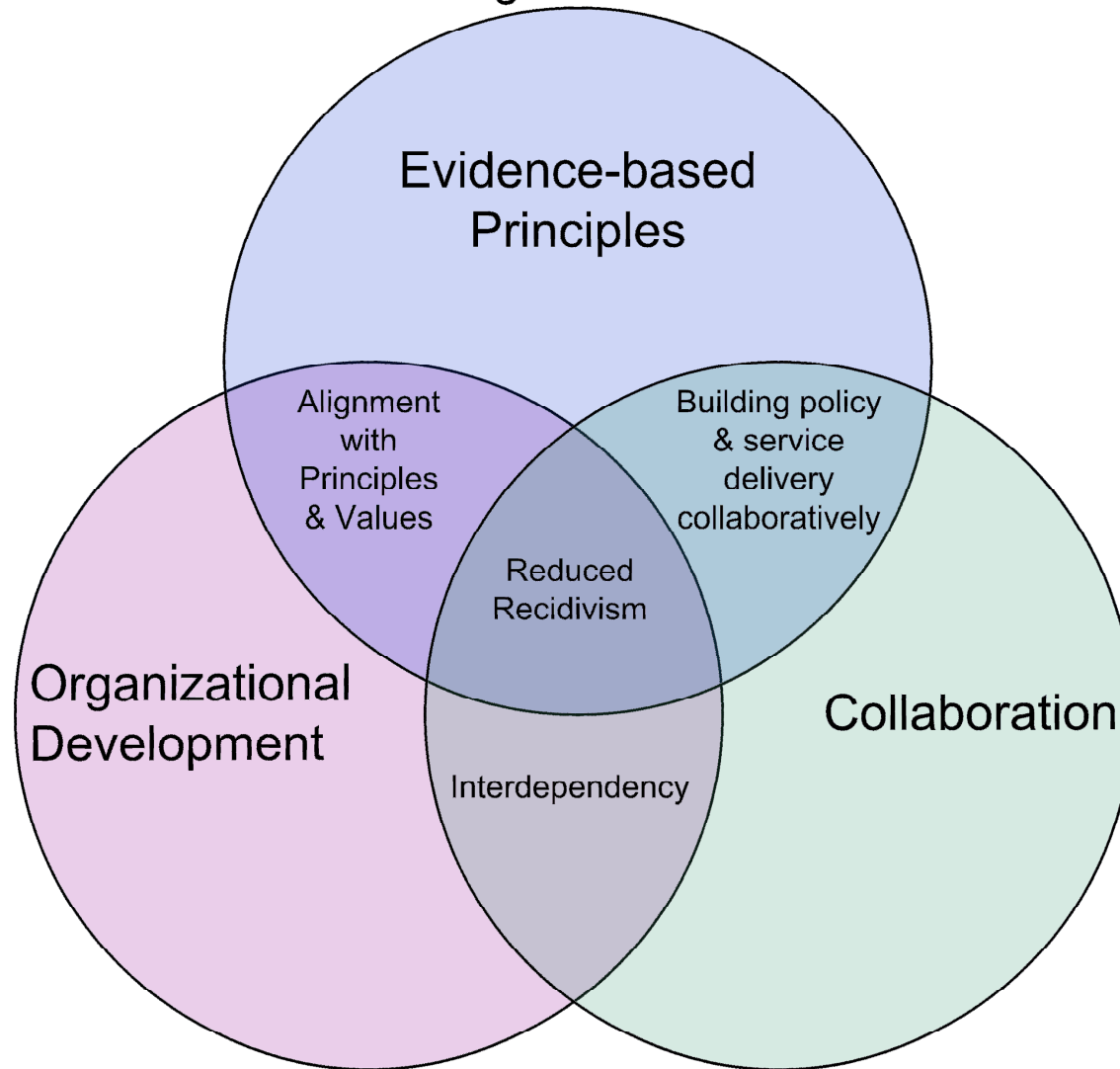

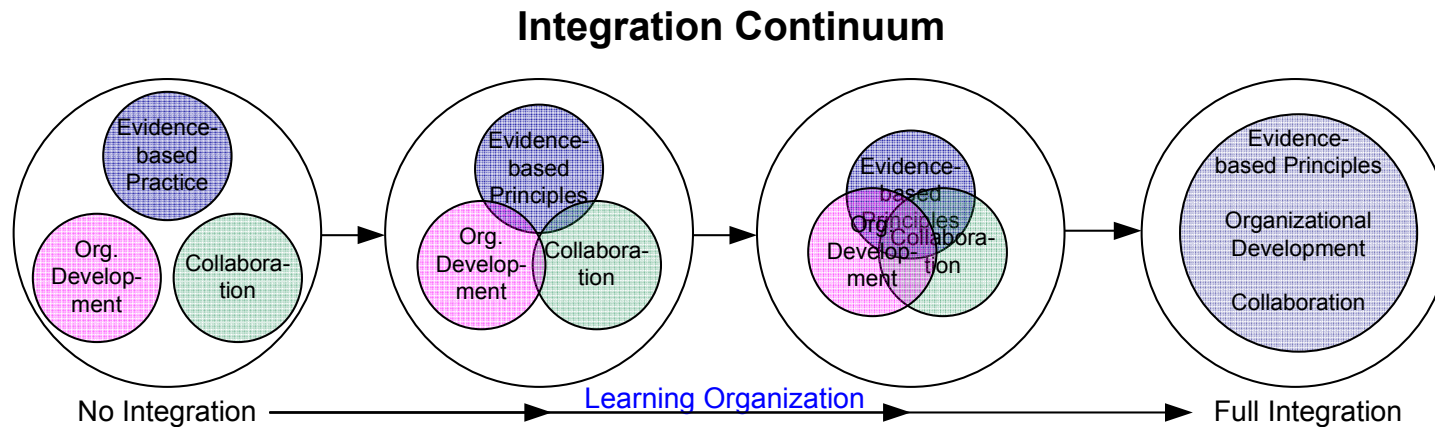

Vision

To build learning organizations that *reduce recidivism* through *systemic integration* of evidence-based practice in collaboration with community and justice partners.





Evaluation

- National Institute of Justice joins the project with evaluation funding for both states through the Statistical Analysis Centers (SAC)
- Convene the National Research Steering Committee
- Fostering partnerships with local SAC's, universities, and pilot sites
- Development of the Measurement Matrix
 - Consistency in data collection between states & sites
 - Aggregate data analysis
 - Ability to measure and monitor process and outcomes
 - Identification of priority Intermediate Measures

- System Process Measures

Intermediate Measures

- **Assessment**
 - % of pop. with completed risk & needs assessment within time frame identified by policy.
 - % of pop. with completed re-assessment within time frame identified by policy.
 - Gain Score (changes in protective measure score as identified through re-assessment).
- **Case Plans**
 - % of medium to high-risk offenders that have case plans developed within time frame identified by policy.
 - % of case plans that address the top 3 identified criminogenic needs according to the assessment.
- **Average length on supervision - sorted by risk level.**
- **Revocations**
 - # of technical violations resulting in revocation to jail.
 - # of technical violations resulting in revocation to prison.
- **Treatment**
 - % of high-risk offenders referred to treatment.
 - % of high risk offenders that attended to treatment.
 - % of total population that attended treatment that are high-risk.
